<u>Headache Science Excellence Tournament 2021</u>

The Juniors Group is organising for the eight time the "Headache Science Excellence Tournament" which will be held virtually during IHC.

The Tournament aims to provide young scientists the opportunity to present their data during a short talk and discussion. Young scientists will not only benefit from sharing their research expertise, but will further improve their communication skills and expand their knowledge in the headache field. The Tournament will be carried out in two groups, one on clinical related research, and one on basic headache research.

We received a total of 110 abstracts for this tournament, which were reviewed in a blinded fashion by the Juniors Group. Six abstracts (3 clinical science and 3 basic science) have been selected for the tournament. The best clinical and basic science presentations, voted by the audience, will receive a trophy and a £500 award.
