## Summary

The Center for Clinical and Epidemiological Research at HUUSP offers a postdoctoral position with a FAPESP grant linked to a Thematic Project that seeks to understand the association of migraine with cerebrovascular outcomes and as a predictor of morphofunctional markers of brain health and subclinical stroke and the influence of lifestyle factors on these associations.

More specifically, the candidate will study the effect of migraine and its characteristics (subtypes and frequency of attacks) on the occurrence of various alterations that can be visualized by 3-tesla magnetic resonance imaging (3T MRI) such as white matter hyperintensities (WMH), lacunae, microinfarcts, and gray matter volume changes in key regions linked to the processing of pain perception. Headache information is available at study baseline (wave 1: 2008-2010), in 2013-14 (wave 2: collection of migraine-specific information) and it will be available in 2021-23 (wave 3: collection of migraine-specific information and other more frequent types such as tension and post-covid). The 3T MRI will be performed during the first two years of this FAPESP thematic project (2023-2024) in a subsample of the ELSA-Brasil cohort from downtown São Paulo.

The candidate is expected to be a leader in this line of research for our group. For this, he/she must meet the following requirements: (i) a doctoral degree (no more than 7 years from this Postdoctoral Fellowship onset) in the health area; (ii) clinical and research experience in neurology (preferably in headache disorders); (iii) proven experience with database analysis; and (iv) advanced knowledge of biostatistics.
