Summary:

The aims of the Secondary Headache Special Interest Group are to:

• promote research into secondary headache;

- improve knowledge about secondary headaches among (general) neurologists, residents and primary care physicians (i.e. when, what and how to further investigate);
- to study the use of ICHD-3 for secondary headache and find ways to improve its use.

Communication:

The SIG members communicated through email and zoom meeting. Some members met during the European Academy of Neurology meeting, although there was no formal planned meeting. An Autumn meeting is being planned.

Publications:

Four publications are in process:

1) A publication about tension-type headache mimics;

2) A manuscript about how to study secondary headache disorders based on the presence of red flags;

3) A proposal about symptomatic episodes indistinguishable from aura;

4) A review about secondary headaches in general.
