Criteria for application

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for an IHS Junior Travel Grant:

A. Currently an under- or post-graduate student (including but not limited to medical students and PhD students) or a medical doctor training to become a specialist. For medical doctors alternatively within 3 years of obtaining medical doctorate or academic post graduate degree or specialist certification, whichever was obtained latest, up to 15 years following MD qualification. For other academic groups alternatively within 6 years of obtaining latest academic degree

B. At least one submitted abstract

OR

If you have NOT submitted an abstract <u>and</u> you are a resident of a World Bank country listed Low-Lower-Middle- or Upper-Middle-income (see list <u>here</u>) please leave the abstract section blank and complete the Summary section only

C. A Junior IHS member (If you are not a member yet, please visit http://www.ihs-headache.org/ to join*)

Value of grant

IHS will aim to cover flight costs for each recipient - costs will be calculated by country using an online flight calculator

Accommodation stipend: US\$ 350

Other costs are the responsibility of the recipient – additional funds for e.g. visa costs can be requested and will be granted in special circumstances
