



IHS Education Committee Report 2024–2025

The Education Committee appointed Marcio Nattan as co-chair alongside Henrik Schytz for the final three years of Henrik's term as Chair.

In 2025, the committee organised Visiting Professor programmes in Kenya (Visiting Professor: Rami Burstein) and Indonesia (Visiting Professors Mario Peres and Gianluca Coppola).

Committee members evaluated and selected recipients for the Headache Trainee Programme (4 Trainee Programmes) and, together with the Scientific Committee, participated in selecting recipients for the IHS Fellowship Programme (up to 3 Fellowships).

The committee continued to review national and regional conference programmes seeking IHS endorsement at the request of the Board. Most were approved, with constructive feedback provided to the organisers where appropriate.

Over the past year, four webinars have been conducted, recorded, and posted on the IHS Learning Center and social media platforms. A public awareness campaign on trigeminal neuralgia was also released at the end of 2024.

An online course on cluster headache has been published, and two additional courses—on headache related to intracranial pressure and on headache management in primary care—are currently in development.

In collaboration with Professor Rami Burstein, the committee has embarked on a major educational initiative in Kenya, which will include onsite teaching in late 2025.

During IHC 2025, the Committee will host interviews with key faculty members, which will be posted on the IHS YouTube Channel.

The Education Committee extends its sincere thanks to all IHS members who have contributed to our online educational activities; their expertise and commitment have been invaluable. We also wish to thank IHS Administrator Carol Taylor and the Communication Committee for their essential collaboration and promotion of our activities across multiple media platforms.

Education remains a cornerstone of the Society's mission. On behalf of the committee, we thank the IHS Board for their ongoing enthusiasm and support.
